### Alarm clock with wireless charger.

Wireless charging is a key function of the device. Just place your smartphone on a special surface to start charging. The LED indicator indicates the battery charge status. The charging surface is protected by a rubber pad, which protects the smartphone case from scratches.

### LARGE, CLEAR LCD DISPLAY

The time displayed is clearly visible even from greater distances. The screen brightness is automatically adjusted depending on the time of day. The user can also manually set the optimal intensity of the displayed content.

### ADDITIONAL USB OUTPUT

The PACW5 clock housing has a USB socket that is used for wired charging of connected devices. It's a convenient solution that allows you to maintain order on the bedside table - without having to connect additional chargers.
